DUE TO THE RECENT SURGE OF COVID 19 CASES HERE IN LANE COUNTY AND IN AN EFFORT TO CONTINUE TO OFFER WINTER ATHLETICS, THE PLEASANT HILL SCHOOL DISTRICT AND SURROUNDING DISTRICTS, WILL BE IMPLEMENTING CAPACITY LIMITATIONS FOR ALL HOME ATHLETIC EVENTS. SPECTATORS WILL BE LIMITED AND TICKETS WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND EVENTS TO ALLOW FOR INCREASED DISTANCING. EACH PLEASANT HILL STUDENT-ATHLETE WILL BE PERMITTED FOUR GUEST TICKETS PER HOME EVENT. LIMITS FOR AWAY GAMES WILL VARY. INSTRUCTIONS ON OBTAINING TICKETS WILL BE EMAILED TO FAMILIES.

SUMMER WORK – YCC

THERE WILL BE A VARIETY OF OPPORTUNITIES TO WORK ON PROJECTS SUCH AS CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIRING TRAILS, PRESERVING AND REPAIRING HISTORIC BUILDINGS, REMOVING INVASIVE SPECIES, ASSISTING WILDLIFE, LAND RESEARCH, LEADING ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS, AND SUPPORTING AGENCY STAFF.
