

Pleasant Hill Middle/High School 2021-2022 COVID-19 Response Plan

Pleasant Hill Middle/High School is planning for In-Person instruction for the 2021-2022 school year. This means that we will be using our normal Bell Schedule with 7 periods a day starting at 8:05 and ending at 3:10 M-TH and 8:05 to 1:30 on Friday. All students will be scheduled into classes as normal with most attending 7 periods a day. Student schedules will be available during our Meet The Teacher Night on Thursday, August 26th, 4pm-6pm. Lockers will not be available. We will not be providing an Online School Experience as it is our expectation that students will be here in the building.

As always, our focus at Pleasant Hill Middle/High School is creating a safe place for students to learn. To ensure that we can continue to offer In-Person instruction, it is vital that we follow the required and recommended mitigation measures that will allow us to remain open for the entire school year. As outlined in the [Oregon Covid-19 Resiliency Framework 2021-22](#), these mitigation measures include:

- The required use of Face Coverings while indoors: [K-12 Face Covering Rule](#)
- Keeping 3 ft. of physical distance.
- Washing hands regularly.
- Universal cleaning.
- Classroom ventilation.

Mitigation measures will help us to avoid COVID-19 outbreaks. In the event that a student needs to quarantine, we will follow OHA and ODE guidelines and the guidance of Lane County Health. In most cases, if a student was in direct contact with COVID-19 it is a required 14-day quarantine. If we are mandated to move to Distance Learning, we will return to Zoom and run our [Distance Learning schedule](#). This schedule is the same as our Friday Early Release schedule and should allow us to transition smoothly.
